Presentation purpose:

Participants will understand what causes implicit bias and how bias affects behavior. The presenter will cover clinical scenarios where implicit bias can adversely impact care. These interactions may take place at any point during a patient's care, from a scheduling phone call to the recording of symptoms, and these interactions can even take place amongst coworkers.
